Krawallgeier - Who are the members of the band and what instrument does each of them play?

The band is formed by us five entities. I (Pondro) to the bass, Alberto at the voice, Thomas on the drum and finally Lorenzo and Med to the guitars.

Krawallgeier - How did the band form?

The band was born in 1998 in Belluno (north of Italy) with a totally different line-up: the only survivors are Alberto, and me. After a long search we have found Lorenzo and Fabio "Med", two guitar players with the right ideas and creativity.

After a short while Giorgio, the drummer with whom we recorded CyberHuman joined the group. Unfortunately after the recording Giorgio had to leave the band but luckily we have now Thomas with us and he is a real skin grinder.

Krawallgeier - Which bands are your paragons?

The band that inspire us and people associate us with, are the masters of floridian scene : Morbid Angel, Obituary, Deicide and Death. Of course among our influences you can find also BayArea thrash metal and melodic death metal from north europe.

Krawallgeier - Do you follow these bands? / Do you copy these bands?

We try to follow the way traced by these holy monsters but we try to develop a personal style to distinguish us in the metal scene of today.

Krawallgeier - How do your songs come into existence?

We usually start from some riffs and ideas from Med, Lorenzo and Alberto who composed a lot.

Then, at rehearsal, we work them out together and often the songs result really different from their original concept. We work them out until we are satisfied. I compose the lyrics instead and Alberto compose the vocal lines.

Krawallgeier - What about gigs? Do you have many gigs?

Live experience is very important, even vital I dare to say. We performed live a lot with important bands like Ensoph, Novembre and your countrymen Asterius lately. At the moment we have interrupted live activity as now many live local are closed. We are planning just a few dates but we won't stop for a long time.

Krawallgeier - Are they well attended?

Many times there was a great amount of people. I must admit that a couple of times we had to play in front of a few fans. But we try to give our best in every situation.

Krawallgeier - Are the people content with your live-Performance?

Up now the people have reacted really well to our live show : they really enjoyed them and had a lot of fun. We are honestly proud about it.

Krawallgeier - How is the reaction of the people referred to your music style? Any criticism?

Well, our musical offer has been accepted really positively in Italy and in east Europe. We also received some criticism but on the whole we are satisfied with the reviews and response we received so far.

Krawallgeier - Why do you make music? (mission, passion, expression, hobby)

Music was initially a hobby for us , a way to spend well our time, then it started to be more and more important for us and now is a fundamental part of our lives, we couldn't stay without playing.

We play to express ourselves in the only way we know : creating music.

Krawallgeier - Let's talk about your albums. / Tell us something about your albums?

Our m-cd "CyberHuman" was recorded last year at Majestic Studios in Scorzè near Venice.

Under the supervision of Marino De Angeli a great producer. It contains five tracks (4 songs and an acoustic instrumental one). Songs are part of a concept about relationship about machines and man, the alienation of the individual caused by the machines and the mark that everyone have from his birth. However lyrics are open to different interpretations : it depends on who is reading them and his way of thinking. Musically you will find death metal with strong florianian influences, with great melodic taste and some surprising electronic inlays.

Krawallgeier - What about the future of the band. Have you got some plans or do you just wait and see?

No! We are not going in relax! We are already composing new songs, some of them heva already been performed live. We are trying to create a trademark sound using guitar synth. New songs will be much more brutal and "in your face".

We are planning new live dates and promoting our music as much as we can. We are not the kind of band who wait and see!
