Krawallgeier - Who are the members of the band and what instrument does each of them play?

Santtu: vocals, Jukka: bass & background vocals, Toby: guitars & background vocals, Tuomo: drums

Krawallgeier - How did the band form?

Santtu's computer music project took the form of a band in the year 2001 when he asked Toby to arrange his music to be played with live instruments. Immediately Tuomo came along to play the drums and Jukka to play the bass. END7 was born.

Krawallgeier - How would you describe your music style?

Metal, between alternative and rapcore. Rap-Metal, maybe? Or as we like to call it, "Extreme nerd metal".

Krawallgeier - Which bands are your paragons?

Tool, Muse, 30 Seconds To Mars, System Of A Down, Red Hot Chili Peppers, Stone Temple Pilots and some finnish bands. But really, the list is endless and these are only a few at the moment in our playlists.

Krawallgeier - Do you follow these bands? / Do you copy these bands?

Of course there is no need to follow or copy other bands. Who would want to do that? "You are what you eat", so the bands we listen may have subconscious influences and similarities in our music. But we do our own thing and create music we enjoy listening to ourselves, and hope the listeners will like it as well.

Krawallgeier - How do your songs come into existence?

Usually Toby, our guitarist, brings the song ideas to the rehearsals and the band together arranges them. The lyrics are made after the song is complete. But, to be honest, the songs are never ready. After they are recorded and printed to hundreds of CD's we stop working on them and concentrate on new songs.

Krawallgeier - What about gigs? - Do you have many gigs?

We have just started to do gigs, so until this day we have had only 3 gigs. More gigs are booked and there are a lot more to come. Some time ago we promised ourselves that we wouldn't do gigs until the band would be ready for it. That is because, all members of the band, excluding Santtu, had performance experience from a numerous bands and projects from the past.

Krawallgeier - Are they well attended?

The first gigs were alright but we know we can do a lot better!

Krawallgeier - Are the people content with your live-performance?

Feedback from the audience has been mostly positive.

Krawallgeier - How is the reaction of the people referred to your music style? Any criticism?

One guy says another and the other guy say another, there are so much conflicts. But we don't care! They can think what ever they want and we will still keep doing what we like. Sad thing is, some people judge bands just because nu-metal has a "bad name" and don't even bother to listen what we have to offer to the scene.

Krawallgeier - Why do you make music? (mission, passion, expression, hobby)

You said it. Music is our lives and playing keeps us mentally healthy. Hopefully this will be a job someday.

Krawallgeier - Let's talk about your albums. / Tell us something about your albums?

We recorded our first EP, called 6543210, in November 2003. It contains 7 tracks. We did everything ourselves, the recording, producing and mixing. Feedback has been diversifying. Reviews has been mostly good and people on our gigs have liked what they heard.

Krawallgeier - What about the future of the band. Have you got some plans or do you just wait and see?

In this business you have to do a lot of work to get noticed and that's what we are doing continuously. We are creating and rehearsing new songs, booking gigs and getting ready to record a new EP at the same time.
