Krawallgeier - How did the band form?

It all started when guitarist Jan contacted his friend and leadsinger Stefan asking him to do some vocals on a few song ideas to get a picture how it could sound. Since the two of them worked so well together they set up a goal to do a high-quality demo but they ended up with 15 strong songs.

Now they started looking for additional members and went for Richard on drums and Magnus on bass to complete the line-up.

Krawallgeier - How would you describe your music style?

We would prefer to call our music some kind of crossover between classical hardrock/heavy metal and modern powermetal. The songs are pretty basic built; interesting verses always followed by strong choruses to catch the listeners attention. So once you've heard a chorus it will stick to your mind.
