Krawallgeier - How did the band form?

TYAG started as a Noise/Goregrind under a different name in the year 1999, it wasn't anything serious and developed. Not until the year 2000 did it start getting more serious and structured.

2002 saw us recording our first Demo/Ep.

Krawallgeier - How would you describe your music style?

Bizarre Brutal Massachusetts Death/Grind.

Krawallgeier - Do you follow these bands? / Do you copy these bands?

We like a lot of their music. We try and take what is expected in Death Metal and Grind and expand on it, and keep an open mind.

Our guitarist usually will come up with a basic idea then we'll jam it all out and try and get a feel for what we want to do. Its pretty free and spontaneous at first then it becomes more set in stone structure-wise. We also like to go back sometimes and add little tweaks and twist to it before its all finished.

Krawallgeier - What about gigs? Do you have many gigs?

Yeah we tend to play out a lot. We like to be as busy and ever present as possible.

Krawallgeier - Are they well attended?

Yeah for the most part we have awesome turn-outs for our gigs and awesome reactions by the "fans".

Krawallgeier - Are the people content with your live-Performance?

Most people seem to really get into what were doing when we play live. We like to barrage, confuse, and stimulate people to the fullest extent of their ability. We like people to just release energy and enjoy.

Krawallgeier - How is the reaction of the people referred to your music style? Any criticism?

There is always somewhat of criticism that comes from playing music. Not enough breakdowns, not enough this or that, or too much of this or that.... we don't really try and focus on what people due when they nay-say, we just play what we like.

Krawallgeier - Why do you make music? (mission, passion, expression, hobby)

All of those are reasons why we started playing music. As it is with all musicians and bands.

Krawallgeier - Let's talk about your albums. / Tell us something about your albums?

Well we've currently released a 5 track Demo/Ep in 2002. We are going to be releasing our debut Full Length CD in 2004. We'll also be releasing a Split CD shortly after our full length is made available.

just wait and see?

Tour. Record a few splits. Write and record a few full lengths.
